#### **Annual meeting of the Parish**

The Annual meeting of the Parish is organised and chaired by the Parish Council but it is not a Parish Council Meeting. It is an opportunity to hear about your community and to raise and discuss local issues and ideas. It is an opportunity to be involved in shaping your community!

#### Welcome

I hope you all had a safe & enjoyable Easter. I think Spring is my favourite season, after the cold of the winter it's nice to welcome Spring and hopefully some sunnier weather back again.

Firstly, I wanted to express my appreciation to the volunteers who planted 1,000 snowdrops in Hengoed Cemetery. We often receive numerous compliments around the cemetery and this will enhance the area.

Councillors continue to work on a potential project to create an avenue of trees on the B5069 towards St Martins. A map of proposed locations for 32 trees has been created and further information is now being sought from Shropshire Highways.

March saw the Council consider a wide range of grants from local organisations and I am pleased to report that we distributed over £6,500 of support to 17 different groups within the community. (More details on page 17)

In April, the Council agreed to complete some long needed refurbishment to the Pavilion to keep it up to date with the needs of our users. We look forward to completing these works as soon as possible.

We also agreed a contractor to complete a large scheme of engineering works to the banks of the River Perry. We've worked with the Shropshire Wildlife Trust to ensure the works minimise impact to the biodiversity already in place and hopefully over the forthcoming years will actually enhance the area and attract more wildlife.

In the coming months, the Parish Council will be carrying out safety inspection of Memorial Headstones at Hengoed Cemetery. Please see page 16 for more information about what this involves.

May gives us the opportunity to celebrate the King's Coronation, the Parish Council has awarded £1,000 to local groups and residents to support the celebrations across the Parish. We will keep our fingers crossed for nice weather. If you are holding a street party or community event, why not send a report in for the next edition of the Parish Roundabout magazine?

Finally, May sees me complete my 2nd year as Chairman and the Parish Council will be given the opportunity to elect another Councillor to lead our Parish Council. On a personal note it's been an absolute privilege and I'm really proud of what we've achieved over the last 2 years.

#### **Parish Outdoor Volunteer Groups**

The Bryn y Castell Coppice Conservation Group and The Selattyn & Gobowen Parish Paths Partnership Group were formed in 2010 and 2017, respectively.

Sadly, I have to report that Mr
Christopher Jenkins, who was a founding member of both Groups, died very recently. A long-standing resident of Gobowen, Chris was a volunteer who invariably turned out for organised sessions, but also worked behind the scenes both in conservation and on individual research of Public Rights of Way.

Chris's volunteer work was wide-ranging. He was a well-known and knowledgeable founding member of the Oswestry Group of Ramblers and The Railway Ramblers. He also contributed to local walking publications such as 'Favourite Walks Around Oswestry & The Borders'.

Chris was a friend, whose enthusiasm and breadth of knowledge and experience of the local maze of public footpaths and cross-country routes was greatly valued and respected.

He will be much in our minds as we continue our outdoor volunteer work in Bryn Y Castell Coppice and in maintaining

the many footpaths and byways of Selattyn & Gobowen Parish.

## Local History Group The Gobowen Hoard

The Selattyn and Gobowen Local
History Group made a modest
contribution to the fund established to
retain in Shropshire the hoard of
Roman coins found in Gobowen in
2019. This was successful.

Emma-Kate Lanyon, curator at the Shrewsbury Museum and Art Gallery has told us that she has begun cataloguing the 337 coins that were found in a field near the old A5 (the exact location is, understandably, not revealed). She explains that the coins imagery provide an insight into Roman beliefs and politics.

In 44BC a comet appeared following the death of Julius Caesar and one coin issued by (Emperor) "Augustus used the image of the comet on his coin to emphasize the familial association with the deified Julius and promote legitimacy of his reign".

She adds that it will take a few weeks to complete records of each coin. The full catalogue will then be placed on their

PC Katie Le'Clere and PCSO Dave Hughes are West Mercia Police's Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) covering this area. They are both happy to be contacted about non-urgent issues in the area and their telephone numbers are shown above but, in an emergency, please ring 999.

Since the start of April there has been an increase in the reports of anti social behaviour (ASB) in Gobowen village., including the following incidents:

- Four youths have gained entry into All Saints' Church and discharged a fire extinguisher.
- \* Several youths have gained access to Holly Cottage on Old Chirk Road. This property is undergoing extensive works and is not a safe environment.
- \* A door has been kicked on Henry

Robertson Drive. Four youths involved ran off and left the area via the footbridge over the railway known as black bridge.

- \* Criminal damage to a boundary fence on Old Chirk Road.
- \* Reports from British Transport Police that children have been sitting on the live railway tracks in Gobowen village. On 13th April, a train driver reported that he had hit their bags which were on the line.

The Police are appealing to all Parents and Carers in the village to talk to their children about these unwanted and dangerous behaviours and help put a stop to it.

#### **Local Policing Community Charter**

In March 2023, West Mercia Police wrote to Town and Parish Councils asking them to identify the top 3 local community issues. These issues form part of a Local Policing Community Charter which aims to focus policing resource. The 3 local issues identified in Selattyn and Gobowen Parish were Anti-Social Behaviour, Road Traffic Collisions and Criminal Damage.

The Parish Council also requested continued community engagement by the Safer Neighbourhood Team.

- 2SV is also known as 2FA (2 factor authentication) and MFA (multi-factor authentication).

#### Step 3 - Stop and think

- Don't panic, don't rush. Stop and think before you continue the call or click.
- · Always be suspicious.
- Police and banks will never ask you for money or personal information.

#### **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that**

Selattyn and Gobowen Parish Council intends to undertake headstone memorial safety testing at:

Hengoed Cemetery

Work is expected to commence in June 2023.

The Council understands that the memorial safety testing may cause concern to grave owners and families of the bereaved and wish to give our reassurance that testing will be carried out respectfully and within national guidelines.

The testing process will involve a visual inspection and a 'hand test'. If a memorial is found to be unsafe, a warning notice will be placed on the memorial, a cordon may be placed around the memorial and a temporary support may be put in place. A letter will be sent to the grave owner at their last known address.

In cases where the grave owner cannot be contacted or has not made appropriate arrangements for the memorial to be made permanently safe, the Council may make arrangements for the memorial to be laid flat.

#### **Parish Council News**

#### **Parish Council Grants**

Each March, the Parish Council considers applications for grants from local groups, projects and charities. This year, 17 grants totalling £6,520 were given as follows:

- Bryn Y Castell Conservation Group—£150 towards group running costs
- Crane Quality Counselling—£100 towards Counselling sessions for local young people.
- Friends of Gobowen School—£250 towards books for pupils
- Gobowen All Rounders—£133 towards sensory equipment
- Gobowen Community Group—£250 towards a pantomime projects
- Gobowen Ladies Guild—£37.50 towards group running costs
- Parish Paths Partnership—£150 towards group running costs
- Selattyn Primary School—£500 towards waterproofs for pupils, planters and gardening equipment and £500 towards an art or music project.
- Preloved Uniform Scheme in Gobowen—£250 towards set up costs.
- Selattyn Show—£100 towards show running costs
- The New Saints FC Community Foundation—£2000 towards Youth Café and holiday activities plus free use of the Pavilion for the sessions.
- Hengoed with Gobowen PCC—£300 towards All Saints' Churchyard maintenance costs
- Selattyn PCC—£300 towards St Mary's Churchyard maintenance costs
- Selattyn Burial Ground—£500 towards maintenance costs
- Gobowen Foodbank—£1000 towards running costs.

#### Road Safety update—Chirk Road

In June 2022, we agreed to fund two new Vehicle Activated Speed Signs (VAS) on Chirk Road in Gobowen, and we were awarded a grant from the Police and Crime Commissioner for 25% of the cost. Due to limitations in the legal powers of Parish Councils, we have not yet been able to purchase and install the signs.

We are currently waiting for Shropshire Council (as the Highways Authority) to finalise its new VAS policy which we hope will enable us to progress this. Keep an eye on our website and facebook page for updates.

#### **Coronation Events**

By the time you read this edition of the Parish Roundabout Magazine, their Majesties King Charles III and Queen Camilla will have been crowned. As mentioned in the last edition of this magazine, the Parish Council offered grant funding for street parties and other events celebrating the Coronation. The following grants were agreed at our meeting in April:

- Hengoed Community Group —£200 towards a street party
- Selattyn Residents—£300 towards a coronation picnic
- Gobowen WI—£40 towards a celebration evening
- St Mary's Church—£150 towards a flower festival
- Meadowbrook Court Residents Association—£100 toward a celebration party
- Perry Road and area residents—£150 towards a street party
- Parish Paths Partnership—£60 towards a Coronation walk.

#### **Current projects**

- A new bus shelter on St Martins Road by the Playing Fields
- Adult Exercise equipment for Gobowen Playing Field.

#### **Local Matters**

#### Hedge and tree cutting

Every house occupier and landowner is responsible for cutting back foliage growth that overhangs the highway. This includes domestic trees and hedges bordering roads and pavements.

So that pavements can be kept as wide as possible and safe for pedestrians, please keep any garden hedges trimmed to your boundary. Generally you must not cut or trim any hedge between 1st March and 31st July to avoid the bird breeding season but they can be trimmed if necessary for safety reasons.

#### **Community Car Scheme**

A small group of residents in St Martins are setting up a Community Car Scheme organised and run locally by volunteers to provide transport for essential journeys where public transport is either unsuitable or not available. The scheme will cover the Gobowen area.

Keep an eye on local noticeboards for details of the scheme launch.

#### **Footpath Diversion Order**

The following information is an extract from a legal notice that Shropshire Council have requested the Parish

Council to make available to residents.


A copy of the document has been displayed on the noticeboard in Selattyn Bus Shelter. The map is shown on page 25 of this newsletter.

On 23rd March 2023, Shropshire Council confirmed a diversion order to Footpath 2(Part) in the Parish of Selattyn and Gobowen.

The effect of the order is to divert.

The full width of that part of Footpath 2 leaving a stile at point A on the Order Map (SJ 26973393) running in a general ENE direction on a natural surface to a stile at point B on the Order Map (SJ 2720 3398). A total distance of approximately 240 meters onto a line leaving FP1 at point C on the Order Map (SJ2697 3398) running in a general easterly direction on a natural surface to a gate at point B on the Order Map (SJ 2720 3398). A total distance of approximately 233 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order map may be seen free of charge at Shropshire Council's offices at the Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, via the Council's website or by emailing outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk.
